The Finance Council Meeting was held on August 3, 2021 in the St Norbert's Church Hall.

In attendance:

- ⇒ Father James opened the meeting with a prayer.
- ⇒ Brad met with General Heating who inspected the boilers. Only one of the two boilers must be replaced as it is leaking.
 - Moving forward automation will be used to switch between the boilers so one does not wear out faster than the other.
 - Both are the same age however only one boiler was leaking.
- ⇒ Quotes for boiler repairs and replacements
 - Brad shared that due to supply issues a new boiler will not be available this year.
 - Brad will continue to research other options and reach out to local contractors for quotes.
 - Brad has been in contact with Lester Endres on ways to continue to use the current boilers through this winter.
 - ♦ The estimate to replace one boiler (materials and labor) was \$57,000.
 - Brad will continue to get bids, firm up a plan and report back to the Finance Council.
 - Any parishioner wishing to donate towards this project should contact Paul or Fr James.
- ⇒ Stain Glass Window Repairs (Brad)
 - Brad gave a very thorough and detailed update on the stained-glass windows. The sodder joints are getting weak, the windows are starting to bow and other sections are very weathered. The replacement value of the taller stained-glass windows is very high thus making the needed repairs ASAP is mission critical. We have delayed these repairs way too long and action is needed.
 - Brad has acquired bids from three companies. The most competitive bid is for \$147,000 but could be broken up into multiple projects fixing the windows in most need first. The windows facing the West are the most urgent for repair before there is a catastrophic failure.
 - Brad will get final quotes and report back to the Finance Council. Any and all parishioners wishing to donate towards the stained-glass windows should contact Paul or Fr James.
- ⇒ The next Finance Council Meeting will be on Tuesday October 5th at 6pm in the St Norbert's Church Hall. Agenda items: Recognition of all the donors to the Renovation Project (Paul and Juanita); status of stained-glass windows and wood platform repairs (Brad); status of boiler repairs and replacements (Brad); 2021-22 Parish budget (Ed); Bank account consolidation (Ed); Employee contract and performance reviews (Eric).
