Sundays: Starting one hour before each Mass, and after the 11:00am Mass.

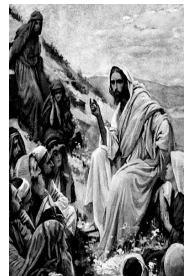
